			Does your companion often ask people to speak up or repeat themselves?
			Is it difficult for your companion to understand you on the telephone?
			Does your companion tell you that you're mumbling or not speaking clearly?
			Can your companion understand soft or whispered speech?
			Do hearing problems cause your companion to visit friends, relatives or neighbors less often?
			Has your companion been exposed to significant noise during work, recreation or military service, to your knowledge?

Scoring: 2 points for Yes 1 point for At Times 0 points for No Scores of 3 or more: Your companion might have a hearing problem. Scores of 6 or more: We strongly suggest a hearing test with our professionals.
